3 Harbormaster Update

Documents presented: Harbormaster Annual Linear Footage.

3.1 Dredging Assessment

The BOS does not like the fixed dredging assessment of \$50/vessel that was proposed by the HAC. The Harbormaster presented an analysis showing the effect of different assessment rates on a USD/Foot basis. After some discussion SL proposed the following motion. "The HAC recommends that the BOS adopt an annual dredging assessment of USD 2.50/foot for slip and mooring holders both commercial and recreational with the additional recommendation that the town match this amount in order to cover the estimated cost of the bond for the dredging project". DL second the motion. Motion passed.

3.2 Tucks Point.

The Harbormaster presented the new layout of the docks at Tucks Point. This new layout resulted from a potential objection by the Conservation Committee. It reduces the length of dockage by 75 feet. SL expressed disappointment with the reduced dock area. There will be a Planning Boards meeting on Monday Feb 8th and a Conservation Committee meeting on Tuesday Feb 9th to discuss this project. If the approval is given and the process goes as planned then the docks could be completed by June.

3.2 Bow & Stern moorings

Bow and Stern moorings will be put in place in area 4 and Area 3 (in front of Crockers and Manchester Marine). Very little objection received. Rhodes 19 will be allowed an area with swing moorings as the vessel does not have an appropriate stern cleat.
