



MBTA COMMUTER RAIL POSITIVE TRAIN CONTROL PROGRAM UPDATE

Advisory: Daytime Rock Drill Work on Rockport Line on November 3-4

Work to occur 7AM-7PM

MassDOT and the MBTA are undertaking federally mandated Positive Train Control (PTC) infrastructure installation which will increase the safety of commuter rail customers and would like to advise the community of upcoming daytime rock drill work within the right-of-way along the MBTA Rockport Line. Due to the equipment necessary to perform this work, high noise levels can be expected.

On the weekend of **November 3-4, 2018**, the PTC Systems Integrator Ansaldo STS USA, Inc. is scheduled to perform rock drilling activities during daytime work hours of between approximately 7AM – 7PM as needed at locations on the in **Manchester-by-the Sea and Gloucester**.

This work is also expected to continue on the weekend of November 10-11, as needed.
