Greetings Boaters,

I left off some items in the last Waterline.

MOORINGS

Any mooring holder who will be leaving the state for the off season and doesn't expect to return before the March 31st mooring renewal date may renew before leaving this fall. Please take advantage of this offer, failure to renew before the cut-off date will mean the loss of your mooring. The process will take a few minutes and you will have peace of mind for months, at least where you're mooring is concerned.

Deliberation moves ahead with regard to mooring fees. Large scale waterfront infrastructure needs will bear heavily on fees.

Safe Boating Course Offered

BOAT MASSACHUSETTS, is a state and nationally approved boating safety course which concentrates on the equipment and operating guidelines needed to enjoy boating in a safe and responsible way. All graduates in the 12 through 15 year old age group will be issued a safe boating certificate allowing them to operate a motorboat without adult supervision, as required by state law. The same is true for 16 and 17 year old youth who wish to operate a personal watercraft (jet-ski, wave runner, etc.) ADULTS are welcome to take class as well!!! You must be twelve years of age no later than October 29th of this year to take this course. Class size is limited to 40.
