

PARKING IN MANCHESTER-BY-THE-SEA

Downtown parking is generally 2-hour parking only between 8am-6pm.
The 2-hour parking takes precedence over any resident sticker or parking placard.

RESIDENT PARKING

All residents will receive a resident sticker in the mail annually in April. The sticker needs to be adhered to the front windshield on the driver's side.

The sticker allows access to all residential parking, entrance to transfer station and parking at Singing Beach.

The sticker does not give you walk on access to Singing Beach.

Residents who do not pay excise tax directly to the Town will need to come to the Town Clerk's office with proof of vehicle ownership and residence in Manchester anytime after May 1st.

Residents who obtain a new car will need to come to the Town Clerk's office with the registration for their new resident sticker.

New residents will need to bring the car registration and proof of residence to the Town Clerks office to obtain their sticker.

Lost stickers will be replaced with a \$10 fee.

Resident stickers are valid from June 1-May 31 each year.

TOWN LOTS

1. Town Hall
 - a. Includes 2 hour parking (8 a.m. to 6 p.m.)
 - b. Includes Resident Sticker parking with no time limit
 - c. Business placard parking allowed from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
 - d. Includes Boater placard parking by boat ramp. No storage of vehicles, boats or trailers
2. Norwood/North
 - a. Includes Resident Sticker parking with no time limit
 - b. Business placard parking allowed from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m
 - c. No storage of vehicles, boats or trailers
 - d. Long term placard parking in specific spots designated by signs
3. Norwood/Brook
 - a. Includes Resident Sticker parking with no time limit
 - b. Business placard parking allowed from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m
 - c. No long term parking
 - d. No storage of vehicles, boats or trailers
4. Masconomo Park
 - a. Includes Resident Sticker parking with no time limit
 - b. No parking 2 a.m. — 6 a.m.
 - c. Visitor parking available for 3 hour time limit where indicated
 - d. Business placard parking allowed from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m
 - e. No storage of vehicles, boats or trailers

PARKING PLACARDS:

Valid June 1st -May 31st .

Placards must be visible on the driver's side of the dashboard.

1. **TEMPORARY Placards:**

Dated placard for residents with a car issue (in shop, etc) which are free.

OR

Parking for short term rentals cost \$50/week with **proof of rental**.

Allows for parking in all residential areas as well as Singing Beach.

2. **CAREGIVER Placards:**

For a resident who needs care placard is free. Allows for parking in all residential areas and Singing Beach.

OR

Nanny placards which require the **car registration and proof of**

employment, costs \$50 and allows for parking in residential areas and Singing Beach during the week only.

3. **BOATER Placard:**

Parking placard is available for mooring holders and town dock slip. **Proof of mooring ownership or dock slip permission**. 1 placard per mooring/slip per owner. It does not include Singing Beach parking.

Allows for parking allowed in specified area behind Town Hall and at Tucks Point and costs \$50.

4. **BUSINESS PARKING:**

Employees at local businesses can purchase a yearlong placard for \$15 with **proof of employment** (letterhead or pay stub).

Allows for parking in 4 designated areas (Norwood lots, town hall and Masconomo Park) between 8am-6pm.

5. **VISITOR PARKING:**

As per the Bylaw section XIV, 2 placards per year per household in certain areas of Town allow for resident street parking in that vicinity. Additional placards will cost \$10/each.

6. **LONG TERM PARKING:**

Resident who needs parking for more than 1 week is available in Norwood/North lot. Requires an application that gets shared with police dispatch.
